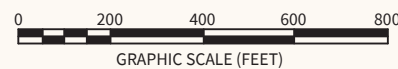

PARK TRAIL DESCRIPTIONS

From scenic vistas to beautiful overlooks, hiking trails at West Virginia's state parks and forests lead to breathtaking mountain scenery. Along the way create lasting memories but remember to leave no trace behind in Almost Heaven.

CATHEDRAL TRAIL

Longest trail at Cathedral. Crosses over several bridges over Rhine creek. Can access other branching trails in park throughout trail.

Distance: 1.1 miles

Difficulty: Easy/Moderate

Blaze: ●

CARDINAL TRAIL

Short trail in the back of the park property making it a good wildlife viewing area.

Distance: 0.2 miles

Difficulty: Easy

Blaze: ●

GIANT HEMLOCK TRAIL

Popular trail due to having some of Cathedral's largest Hemlocks along trail.

Distance: 0.2 miles

Difficulty: Easy/Moderate

Blaze: ○

WOOD THRUSH TRAIL

Only trail that covers both sides of the park crossing route 50. Heavily wooded, use caution crossing highway.

Distance: 0.6 miles

Difficulty: Easy/Moderate

Blaze: ●

PARTRIDGE BERRY TRAIL

Slight inclined trail with many bird sightings. Trail branches off in Cardinal Trail.

Distance: 0.6 miles

Difficulty: Easy

Blaze: ●

OWL TRAIL

Wooded walk that accesses through a field, good wildflower and wildlife viewing area.

Distance: 0.6 miles

Difficulty: Easy

Blaze: ●

TRILLIUM TRAIL

Very short trail connecting along Old Oakland road at the far end of the park, branches off into Cardinal Trail.

Distance: 0.1 miles

Difficulty: Easy
